



In 1938 Stretton's Brewery proposed to build a public house and residential hotel, to be named The Spinners, on Max Road. Work had not begun at the start of the war and the planning permission lapsed during the war. It would be another twenty years before the short lived Rhino pub was built. The name was taken from a rhinoceros head displayed there. The Rhino was demolished in 2011/12 and eleven houses on a road with the uninspiring name of Holmeigate Close now stand on its site.
